We have made our deposit for camp, and we are really looking forward to it.


We will be having some upcoming fundraisers such as a Pancake Fundraiser and car wash, be on the lookout for more information soon.

Administrative Team (David Hughes -Team Leader/Ricky Watson -Co-Leader):




