<u>Voting Instructions</u>: Only church members present are allowed to vote.

Vote for EACH candidate separately.

Circle "Yes" if you agree with the candidate serving as a Deacon or Circle "No" if you disagree with the candidate serving as a Deacon.

<u>Notes:</u> All candidates have been contacted and have agreed to serve if elected.

All candidates must receive a vote on this ballot.

Any ballot not marked "Yes" or "No" for EACH individual candidate will be deemed ineligible and WILL NOT BE COUNTED.

To be elected, each candidate must receive at least a 75% favorable vote

We look forward to sharing our camp experience with you on Youth Sunday which is set for Sunday, August 15! We hope that you plan to join us!


