Administrative Team (Ricky Watson -Team Leader/David Hughes-Co-Leader):

The Administrative Team continues to meet monthly to review the monthly financial reports, discuss any needed changes to the Constitution & By-Laws, and monitor the Church's investment accounts. In addition to the normal activities, at the last meeting, we began working on the 2023 Baptist Tabernacle Budget and will continue working on it to present to the Church at the January Church Conference.

Beginning last month, the Administrative Team began providing a review of the Constitution & By-Laws each month in the newsletter. Due to the length of Article III, we will provide that article in portions monthly. This month we continue with <u>Article III, Section 2: Terms of Pastor, Officers, and Ministry Teams</u> for review. If you have any questions about any of these Articles, please ask one of the Administrative Team Members. **NOTE: Some of these sections are currently in revision, what is provided to you in this article is what is currently approved.**

If you do not have a copy of the Constitution & By-Laws, please contact the Church Secretary for a copy.

Article III (Approved 4/18/18)

Section 2: TERMS OF PASTOR, OFFICERS AND MINISTRY TEAMS

A. Pastor

The pastor shall serve indefinitely at the will of the church. Whenever a vacancy occurs a pastor shall be called by the church to serve until the relationship is dissolved at the request of either the pastor or the church. In either case, at least thirty days notice shall be given of termination of the relationship, unless otherwise agreed upon, with both pastor and church seeking to follow the will of God through the leadership of the Holy Spirit.

B. Officers and Ministry Teams

The terms of all other officers, teachers, and Ministry Team members shall be specifically provided in these by-laws.

Section 3: Elections

A. <u>Pastor</u>

The call of the pastor shall take place at a meeting especially for that purpose of which at least one week's notice has been given to the membership. The elections shall be upon the recommendation of a Pastor Search Committee after consultation with the Administrative Ministry. The Pastor Search Committee shall bring only one name at a time for the consideration of the church and no nominations shall be made except by the committee. Elections shall be by secret ballot. An affirmative vote of 85% of church members present and voting is necessary for an extension of a call. Should the minister recommended by the committee fail to receive an 85% vote, the committee will be instructed to seek out another minister and the meeting at which the vote was taken shall be adjourned without debate.

The Pastor Search Committee shall be nominated by the Church Leadership Team and voted on by the church. The Pastor Search Committee shall consist of a minimum of five church members in good standing with the church and represent the following organizations:

One from Pastoral Ministry Team (Deacons);

Two from Missions Team (Women On Mission and Brotherhood) (One to serve as a an alternate);

Two from Age Specific Ministry Teams (Youth Council; Senior Citizens) (One to serve as an alternate)

One from Worship Ministry Team

One from Administrative Ministry Team.

At the discretion of the Pastor Search Team, the entire team can serve as a whole (seven members); however, only five are needed to recommend a perspective pastor to the church for a vote

The Leadership Team shall also recommend the Chairman of the Pastor Search Committee to be voted on by the church.

To ensure there is not a tie vote on the recommendation of the prospective pastor, the committee shall be an odd number of persons.

The pastor's position description and Benefit Package is contained in the Personnel Manual and Job Descriptions. It can be revised only by approval of the church at a regular church conference.

B. Youth/Children's Director (Approved 4/15/09) (revised 7/21/21)

The call of the Youth/Children's Director shall take place at a meeting especially for that purpose of which at least one week's notice has been given to the membership. The elections shall be upon the recommendation of the Youth/Children's Director Search Committee after consultation with the Administrative Ministry Team. The Youth/Children's Director Search Committee shall bring only one name at a time for the consideration of the church and no nominations shall be made except by the committee. Elections shall be by secret ballot.

An affirmative vote of 85% of church members present and voting is necessary for an extension of a call. Should the candidate recommended by the committee fail to receive an 85% vote, the committee will be instructed to seek out another candidate and the meeting at which the vote was taken shall be adjourned without debate.

The Youth/Children's Director Search Committee shall be nominated by the Leadership Team and voted on by the church. The Youth/Children's Director Search Committee shall consist of a minimum of five church members in good standing with the church and represent the following organizations:

One from Pastoral Ministry Team (Deacons);

One from Missions Team (Women On Mission and Brotherhood)

One from Age Specific Ministry Teams (Youth/Children's Advisory Council)

One from Worship Ministry Team;

One from Administrative Ministry Team.

The Leadership Team shall also recommend the Chairman of the Youth/Children's Director Search Committee to be voted on by the church.

To ensure there is not a tie vote on the recommendation of the prospective Youth/Children's Director, the committee shall be an odd number of persons.

The Youth/Children's Director Position description and Benefit Package is contained in the Personnel Manual and Job Descriptions. It can be revised only by approval of the church at a regular church conference.

C. Church Secretary (revised 4/18/18)

The church secretary shall be hired by the Personnel Committee (Deacons) and the Pastor. No vote by the Church is required to hire the Church Secretary.

Church Staff (i.e., choir director, custodian, etc.)

Church staff shall be recommended to the church by a committee appointed for such purpose, which includes the pastor as an ex officio member, at a special called Church Conference for that purpose of which at least on week's notice has been given to the membership. The committee shall be appointed at a regular church conference by a recommendation and vote of the church and comprised of individuals interested in working to interview such positions and have a desire to employ the best candidate for the position. A position description and salary shall be developed by the appointed committee after consultation with the Administrative Team (for salary) and approval of Church Relation Deacon Ministry Team.

The vote for the church staff shall be by secret ballot at a regular church conference, with a majority of those members voting for the extension of an offer to hire the staff.

E. Deacons.

Deacons for the church shall be elected at a business meeting called for that purpose. Refer to Article IV for details on Deacon Election.
