
# From the Pastor's Desk:



The Administrative Team meeting for November consisted of the usual reviews of the financial reports, investments, and a discussion of the church insurance policies. For the month, most of the meeting consisted of discussing and planning the 2024 Church Budget as recommended by the Ministry Teams. The final 2024 Church budget will be presented at the regularly scheduled January Church Conference.

This month we will feature the Leadership Team which is included in Article III of the Constitution & By-Laws. The Leadership Team consists of the current Team Leaders of each of the Ministry Teams and the Church Moderator. The Chairman of the Deacons will serve as the Leadership Team Chair. Monthly, the Leadership Team will hold a planning meeting of the Ministry Teams which includes the <a href="two">two</a> Team Leaders of: Administrative, Bus, Discipleship, Evangelism, Fellowship, Missions, Pastoral, Property Management, and Worship and <a href="tone-leader-each of the Age-specific">tone-leader-each of the Age-specific (Children, OWLS, Youth)</a>. This meeting is to review needs, set goals, prepare plans to reach those goals, and evaluate the progress of the church. Also, the Leadership Team will approve expenditures of the Ministry Teams if they are within the approved budget. Expenditures that are not within the approved budget must be approved by the Church at a regular Church Conference. <a href="Please note that this is not an open meeting">Please note that this is not an open meeting</a>, but a working meeting of the approved Leadership Team. Recommendations of the Leadership Team are then presented to the Church at open Church Conferences for Church approval.
