



## What are our Ministry Teams up to?

Thank you to everyone who attended our Deacon sponsored Special Prayer Service. It was a very meaningful service. The Deacons are delivering the announcements during the Sunday Worship Service to provide our pastor with additional time to greet the congregation. #### Administrative Team (Ricky Watson-Team Leader/Kelly Currie-Co-Leader):

We mentioned in last month's Newsletter Article from the Administrative Team about passing the 2020 Baptist Tabernacle Church Ministry Budget at the called Church Conference in December. What we didn't mention was that the total budget amount for the 2020 Baptist Tabernacle Church Year is **\$458,106**. This is an increase over the 2019 budget of over \$92,000. That is quite a jump, but we want to meet the needs of the Church by providing a budgeted amount that was requested by all the Ministry Teams. Now, the charge to the Church is to provide the income to meet that budget through our annual Tithes and Offerings.

As you know, we do not require our members to pledge an amount that you plan to give each year. We prepare more of a "faith based" budget in that we plan and approve a budget and have faith that the Church will meet those needs. As the Church year moves on, the Administrative Team will monitor the income verses the expenditures to ensure that the expenditures do not exceed the income. If we identify a problem, the Administrative Team is charged to advise the Church of the short comings and suggest a solution to the Church. That may mean that some planned activities will need to be modified or cancelled. This is something that none of us wants to happen. So, let's all focus on your Tithes & Offerings during the year! We hope that the Church Members will accept the challenge of the 2020 Budget and provide the income needed through our Tithes and Offerings.



## From the Pastor's Desk:

Every February, there comes a time when we set aside an entire day to celebrate love. We call it Valentine's Day. When I was a boy, in grade school, we would anticipate this day because we would exchange Valentine cards and have a party with cupcakes. Even our teacher, that never smiled, was nice on that day. As I have grown older, I have been amazed at the way people have created an expectation of what should happen on this one single day.

When I was in High School, there was this girl who called herself my "girlfriend." As this one day approached, she told me that she expected candy and flowers and that I was to present them to her in front of her friends. She was a bit angry and hostile when I told her that her requirements for Valentine's Day would not be fulfilled by me. She said that we were finished. I was relieved, and she immediately began her search for a willing participant who would satisfy her romantic ideal for this one day. From this experience grew a philosophy that I still live by. I determined to acknowledge "the day", however, I would not limit my expressions of love for those that I cherish to just one day. FYI...Annette can verify this to be true!

What if God limited His love for us to one day? Which day would it be? If you are waiting for Valentine's Day to show love for someone special, then you are missing a valuable part of our human experience. The expressing and demonstration of love for one another is not reserved for just one day or some "Hallmark" inspired occasion. The expression of our love for one another should be a natural part of how we live each day of the year!

Jesus provides the greatest example of an expression of true love. He came to earth, the Son of God, to take our sins to the cross of Calvary, where He suffered, bled, and died for us.
