Property Management Team (Steve White-Team Leader):

Well another year is gone, hope all of you had a blessed Christmas and will have a blessed New Year.

First thing we can all do is pray for this Country and one another.

We did have a clean up day that went very well. Got several rooms cleaned out and straightened up. The Kitchen was cleaned and items removed that were no longer needed. Thanks to all that helped out with this. We hope to do this again in the Spring. The tile in the FMC Kitchen and Foyer were cleaned, it looks so much better. Please sweep and mop after each cooking event.

New carpet will be going into the office area (Secretary Office, Pastor Office, Youth Director Office and hallway) also in the breezeway between the Sanctuary and the FMC. This should be the remaining carpet needing to be replaced in the Church. This is to be done after painting has been completed in these areas. Painting should be begin as you read this newsletter.

Kevin Creech fixed a gutter outside the breezeway between the Sanctuary and the FMC that was causing a leak in that area. Kevin has done a lot of repairs at the Church and accepts no pay. If you see him, please thank him for helping with the up keep of this Church.

Our budget for 2020 was approved at a called conference on December 18th. You will see a \$50,000 increase in capital improvement. The \$50,000 will not be an improvement but a badly needed repair. If you have been outside to the back of the FMC you would have noticed the asphalt pavement cracking and crumbling. Sink holes have begun around the man holes. Be careful when driving into this area. We had an engineer assess the area and his recommendation was to tear up and remove all asphalt and replace with six to eight inches of compacted stone, then a layer of no less than one and one half inches of asphalt. He believes the job was not done right the first time. We will be contacting highly recommended asphalt companies to estimate repairs needing to be done. Hopefully this will be done in the next few weeks.

We will continue to work for the upkeep of this church and the Glory of GOD. May he bless us all.

Update from our Bus/Van Committee

At this time the bus search committee is still in the process of researching the most appropriate solution for the needs of BTC. As of now the focus will remain on a 15 passenger bus due to the fact that any higher capacity vehicle would require a Commercial Drivers License

that any higher capacity vehicle would require a Commercial Drivers License (CDL). This would limit the amount of qualified drivers legally allowed to operate it for BTC. The bus committee asks that each team within BTC would provide a list of members willing to drive a 15 passenger bus for use with specific teams outreach and transport needs. Applications are due by January 31, 2020.


January & February Monthly Missions Offering
