With growth comes many more opportunities for us to serve in a multitude of ways. Please reach out to a team member or deacon to find out how you can help with one of the many ministries going on within our church. Many hands make light work!

# Administrative Team (Ricky Watson -Team Leader/David Hughes-Co-Leader):

Happy New Year from The Administrative Team! We continue to meet monthly to review the monthly financial reports, discuss any needed changes to the Constitution & By-Laws, and monitor the Church's investment accounts. In addition to the normal activities, at the last meeting, we continued to work on the 2023 Baptist Tabernacle Budget which will be presented to the Church for approval at the January Church Conference.

Continuing with the review of the Constitution & By-Laws, this month will continue with Article III. This month we continue with Article III, Section 3: Elections, beginning with paragraph F. Church Ministry Teams, Teachers, and Officers. If you have any questions about any of these Articles, please ask one of the Administrative Team Members. **NOTE: Some of these sections are currently in revision, what is provided to you in this article is what is currently approved.**If you do not have a copy of the Constitution & By-Laws, please contact the Church Secretary for a copy.

Article III (Approved 4/18/18)

Section 3: Elections

#### F. Church Ministry Teams, teachers, and officers

Church Ministry Teams, teachers and officers shall be elected at the regular August Business meeting.

#### G. Church Leadership Team (Revised 10/20/21)

- Each leadership ministry team will have two leaders, except age specific team, which will have three (Children, Youth, and Senior Adult)
- 2. Ministry Team leaders will be recommended by current Team leaders and presented for consideration to the Leadership Team. Upon approval of the Leadership Team, the Leadership Team will recommend the Team Leaders at the July Church conference for Church approval. There is no limit on the time members or leaders may serve on each team. Note: Additional nominations may be made from the floor during the Church Conference.
- No person may serve as a ministry team leader of more than one ministry team in any given year.
- Two persons from the same family may not serve as leaders of the same ministry team in any given year. (Family is defined as spouse, child, grandchild, sibling, stepfamily)
- 5. Ministry Team Leaders will suggest 5-7 persons to serve on the Core Team. These persons should be passionate about ministry and have displayed dedication to ministry. These 5-7 persons will be affirmed by the church each year at the August church conference. Other Team members are considered supplemental members and do not need to be voted on by the Church.
- 6. Ministry Leadership Teams have the freedom to, and are encouraged to supplement their Ministry Team as needed during the year. This is done by the recruiting persons throughout the year to help carry out various tasks and/or supplement the Core Team. These supplemental members do not need to be voted on by the Leadership Team or the Church.
- Ministry Team Leaders will attend Leadership Team Meetings once a month to review needs, set goals, prepare plans to reach those goals, and evaluate the progress of the church. Ministry Team Leaders may choose to revise meeting schedule as necessary.
- Ministry Teams will give a report concerning their area of ministry at each Church Conference. This is to keep the Church informed of Ministry Team activities.
- Vacancies which occur during the year shall be filled by recommendation to the church by the Leadership Team at the recommendation of the leaders of the individual ministry team. The

leadership team shall bring a nomination of an individual to a regular scheduled church conference.

10. Leaders of the Ministry Teams are to be:

- Gifted in the Ministry.
- Passionate in the Ministry.
- Dedicated to the Ministry.
- Strongly encouraged to tithe.
- Support the overall Ministry of the Church.
- 11. New church members serving on Ministry Teams will serve as apprentices for a year on the team prior to serving as a full Ministry Team member.
- 12. The Church Relations Deacon Ministry Team (Deacons) consists of:
  - a. The active Deacons and is considered the Deacon Ministry Team).
     The Deacons, which are nominated and elected by the Church, will also serve as the Church Relations Deacon Ministry Team (former Personnel Committee).
  - The Chair and Vice Chair of the Deacons will serve as the Deacon Ministry Team Leaders,
  - c. The balance of the team will consist of the other active deacons.
- 13. No paid staff or family member of the paid staff will serve on the Church Relations Deacon Ministry Team or Administrative team.

#### 14. Inactive or ineffective Ministry Team Leaders or members:

- Ministry Team Leaders determined to be inactive or ineffective by the Leadership Team will be evaluated by the Leadership Team with appropriate action taken by the Leadership Team, up to and including replacement.
- b. If a team member or members are not actively serving on the Ministry Teams, as approved by the Church, the Leadership Team will discuss and take the appropriate action.
- 15. All team leaders must have been a church member for at least one year. Core team members shall also be church members.
- 16. The Chair of the Deacons will serve as the Leadership Team Chair. The Chair is responsible to assure that:
  - a. Items are systematically discussed, and a consensus is reached on the items during the Leadership Team meetings,
  - Decisions made by the Leadership Team are reported back to the Church at the next scheduled Church Conference by the Leadership Team Chair,
  - Items to be considered by the Church at Church Conference are provided to the Moderator at least one week prior to the Church Conference
  - d. Items are to be presented by the Leadership Team Chair at the Church Conference as items from the Leadership Team.
  - e. Items assigned to the Leadership Team by the Church during Church Conference will be promptly considered and reported on

- at the next Church Conference, until a decision is made by the Church
- The Church Moderator will serve on the Leadership Team as an ex-officio member.
- The Church Secretary will serve as the Leadership Team Secretary and maintain all minutes.

#### Section 4: Other

- A. With the exception of call of pastor, nothing herein shall prevent any member from nominating other person or persons for any officer, committee, or teaching position.
- All officers, teachers, and committees shall be elected by a majority
  of the votes cast.

#### Section 5: Dismissal

#### 1. Church Staff (revised 4/18/18)

- a. Dismissal of the Pastor, Youth/Children's Director, Choir Director (paid), custodian, etc.) must be at the recommendation of three of the following Church Leaders: Deacon Chairman, Sunday School Director, Women on Mission Director, Brotherhood Director, or the Personnel Committee Chairman, at the recommendation of the Personnel Committee. A recommendation must be made at a special called Church Conference for that purpose with at least one week's notice being provided to the church membership. Justification for the dismissal must be provided by the persons recommending the dismissal at that meeting. The vote shall be by secret ballot requiring the same percentage to dismiss as was required to hire the individual. This is: Pastor and Youth/Children's Director—85%.
- Dismissal of the Church Secretary shall be by the Personnel Committee (Deacons) and the Pastor. No Church vote is required.

#### 2. Deacons

Deacons may be dismissed at the recommendation of the Deacons at a special called Church Conference for that purpose with at least one week's notice being provided to the church membership.

Justification for the dismissal must be provided by the Deacons during this special meeting. The vote shall be by secret ballot requiring the same percentage to dismiss a Deacon as was required to call the individual. That vote is 75% of those members voting.

(Please note that this section is currently undergoing revision and will be voted on at the January Church Conference. The revised section will be issued after approval.)
