
# From the Pastor's Desk:

ARTICLE IX (Approved 11/19/0

#### BUR

#### General

- . Cemetery Plots:
  - No one can select a plot in advance regardless of whether they are a member of this church or not. A wife or husband will be left one lot beside them if they die and either are members. If a child under 18 years old is unmarried and dies, two plots will be left for his mother and father if they are still living.
  - If a wife or husband is a member of this church, the other partner can be buried, even though the other is not a member. Children less than 18 years old will be treated the same as members.
  - Regardless of the age of the child, if the child is physically or mentally disabled and dependent on the parent; a cemetery plot will be furnished at death at no charge providing the parent is a member of this church.
  - Beginning January 1, 2009, a cemetery maintenance fee of \$500.00 will be charged for each individual being buried in the Baptist Tabernacle Cemetery. This fee applies to all members, regardless of age, position, or number of years of membership in Baptist Tabernacle Church.
  - The intent of this Maintenance Account is for the cemetery to be "self-supporting" and to not be a burden on the church.
  - The Cemetery Maintenance Fee will be administered by the funeral homes and placed in the account.
  - Members will be allowed to pay into the Maintenance Account in advance.
    - This may be done in installments or a lump sum payment. Installment payments must be a minimum of \$25.
    - b. Members or others may donate to other members' Maintenance Account for other members.
  - 3. The fee will be deposited into a Cemetery Maintenance Account for the purpose of maintaining the cemetery. Cemetery maintenance includes: 1) grass mowing of cemetery not enclosed by some type of border, 2) grass mowing of those burial plots that are not enclosed with some type of border, 3) spraying Roundup around the headstones of those graves not enclosed by some type of border.
  - Effective January 1, 2009, <u>no</u> graves on the north side of the path, separating the old portion of the cemetery from the new part, will be allowed to have any permanent stones above ground level. This will allow for easier maintenance of the cemetery.
