

# What are our Ministry Teams up to?

# Pastoral Team (Ricky Narron-Team Leader/Jimmy Faison-Co-Leader):

The Deacons continue to visit shut-ins with calls, cards, and prayers. God is good today, tomorrow, and all the time!

## Administrative Team (David Hughes -Team Leader/Ricky Watson -Co-Leader):



The Administrative Team continues to meet monthly to discuss and manage our required responsibilities of reviewing the previous monthly financial report, including the income, expenditures, all Ministry Team's expenditures for the month, as well as the investments we have through Edward Jones. Specifics discussed at the past meeting were the increases in the deductibles in the Church

Insurance for 2024 and the increase in the premium. Also, we discussed the need to add an Errors and Omissions rider to the Liability Insurance. We also discussed the continuing emails received from Church Mutual about who the property manager is. It was decided that this should be one of the Building and Grounds Team. We will discuss that with them. We also decided that we would deposit \$10,000 from our general checking account in a CD at KS Bank in Wendell that will allow us to get a credit card from them. The credit card was applied for on October 17. As of now, they have asked for additional information prior to approval. At the request of the Leadership Team, we made some changes to the Rayford and Lillian Driver Scholarship Guidelines and updated the Guidelines for use of the Church buildings to allow dancing at wedding receptions in the FMC for father/daughter, mother/son, and bride/groom dances only. These changes were provided to the Leadership Team at the October meeting for their review and approval.

This month we will provide the change to the Guidelines for use of the Sanctuary, Family Ministry Center, and the Education Building. The change is specifically to allow for dancing at weddings in the FMC. This was approved at the October Church Conference. New pages will be provided to all holders of the Constitution and By-Laws.

# Guidelines for use of the Sanctuary, Family Ministry Center, and the Education Building.

The change applies only to the Family Ministry Center. It is included in Section A: Basic Guidelines paragraph 3. General, paragraph o, which now states the following:

- o) The Traditional first dances are permitted (that is dancing by the bride and groom, father and daughter, mother and son and parents) at a wedding reception held in the Family Ministry Center. Dancing is not permitted at any other location on church property.
  - All music, live or otherwise must be approved by the Worship Ministry Team. Music selections must be appropriate for a Church setting. A BTC trained sound team member will operate the sound equipment if the sound equipment is to be used. At the close of the traditional dances, dancing will cease. Soft music of the same kind may continue. At no time are D/J's permitted.
