Food For Thought

From God:

To: All His Children

From the Administrative Team

This month, we wanted to remind the Church members of the policies of using the Church facilities. In April 2015, the Church approved revised Guidelines for use of the Sanctuary, Family Ministry Center, and the Education Building. Following are some of the highlights of these guidelines. For a full list of the guidelines, please review them in the Constitution and By-Laws. As always, if you have any questions, please contact one of the members of the Administrative Team.

Basic Guidelines:

• Church Related

- 1- All activities are to be schedule with the Church Secretary. This will alleviate two organizations trying to use the facilities at the same time.
- 2- There is no cost for Church Related Activities.
- 3- All materials used for the activity must be removed at the completion of the activity and the facility put back in the original configuration.

• Non-Church Related

- 1- Schedule use of the facility with the Church Secretary.
- 2- Review and sign the Facility Usage Agreement and return to the Secretary.

General

- 1- All church meetings, functions, and activities sponsored by Baptist Tabernacle Church will have first priority in the use of the facilities.
- 2- Activities that are not church related or church

sponsored are to be scheduled with the Church Secretary and **approved** by the Leadership Team.

- 3- There is no fee for the use of the church facilities by church members; however, a \$50 refundable deposit is required at the time of reservation. All donations to offset expenses will be appreciated.
- 4- Facilities will be inspected after use for any damage and cleanliness.
- 5- Arrange for your own entry to the facilities.
- 6- Smoking is not permitted in any of the buildings. Alcoholic beverages are not allowed on Church property.
- 7- No food or drinks are allowed in the Church Sanctuary or other carpeted areas of the facilities at any time. NOTE: This is important since we have just replaced the carpet in both the Education Building and the Sanctuary.
- 8- Church members shall reserve the facilities under their names for non-church members.
- 9- Decorations shall not be attached to walls, ceiling, or light fixtures. Nails, pins, tacks, glue, screws, wires, staples, or thumbtacks shall not be used.
