<u>Administrative Team (Ricky Watson -Team Leader/David Hughes-Co-Leader):</u>

As we begin the new Church year in September, we thought a summary of the Administrative Team responsibilities would be beneficial to the Church membership. This is especially important since we are coming off the COVID years when the activities of the Church were in such disarray. Also, with the number of new members of the Church, this may be helpful to understand some of the operations of the Church.

The Administrative Team is responsible for all the administrative activities of the Church, including Finance, Constitution & By-Laws, Counting Committee, Church Treasurer, Church Clerk, Church Moderator, and Insurance.

Like all the Ministry Teams, the Leaders of the Administrative Ministry Team are recommended by the current Team Leaders and presented to the church for approval. Leaders then choose their team members and these members are voted on by the church. Length of service is one year.

Following are the areas of responsibility of The Administrative Ministry Team:

Financial

Supervise or assist in the supervision of an accounting system that provides adequate internal controls to protect all funds and workers. This is done through the preparation of an annual church budget with input provided by the other Ministry Teams. We also recommend policies and procedures for receiving, ac-

counting, disbursing, and reporting church monies; implement the policy for spe-

cial funds that are in addition to regular tithes and offerings; update and maintain guidelines approved by the Internal Revenue Service for the use of all church monies and gifts; and prepare a monthly Financial Report with the assistance of the Church Secretary.

Constitution & By Laws:

Maintain the content for the constitution and bylaws by compiling all written copies of policies and procedures the church has already approved. This includes ensuring that the Ministry Teams understand their responsibilities and implement those responsibilities as described in the Constitution & By Laws.

Counting

Annually nominate a Counting Team to be approved by the Church membership. This team consists of the Treasurer, Assistant Treasurer, Sunday School Director and Assistant, and Sunday School Secretaries.

Insurance

Ensure that the Church has proper insurance coverage of all church assets and liabilities including the Pastor, contractors, and employees of the Church.

Church Clerk/Assistance Church Clerk

Annually, nominate a church clerk and assistant church clerk to be approved by the Church membership.

Church Treasurer/Assistant Treasurer

Annually nominate a church treasurer and assistant treasurer to be approved by the Church membership.

Moderator

Annually, nominate a Moderator to be approved by the Church membership.
